



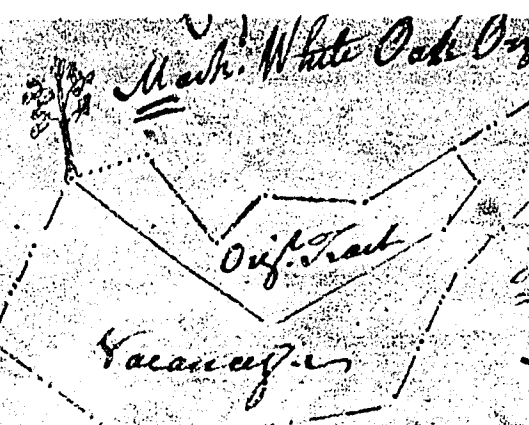
## Survey of "Woolf Ridge" for Peter Gordy II

Peter Gordy I received a warrant for "Woolf Ridge" containing 50 acres in Worcester County Maryland on 6 November 1750. On 21 March 1759 a survey of the land was recorded and he assigned the warrant to to his son, Peter Gordy II. The document includes the survey description and plat. We do not have the citation information for this document.

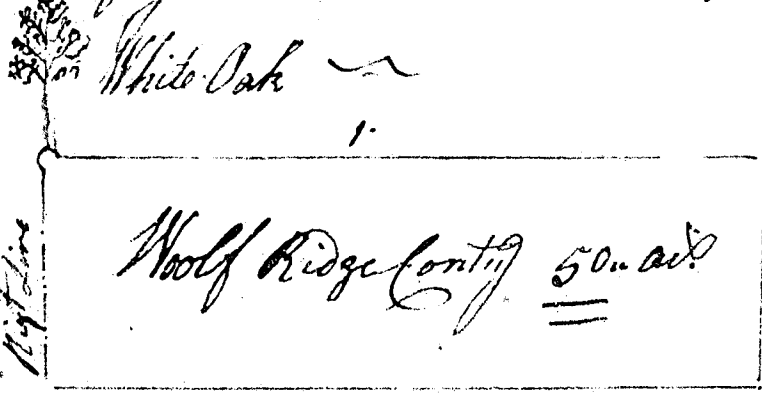

Maryland Worcester County 11 March 7<sup>th</sup> 21<sup>st</sup> 1759

By virtue of a common Warrant granted unto Peter Gaudy Junr. of Worcester County for fifty acres of Land bearing date the 6<sup>th</sup> day of Novemb. Anno Domini 1750. Which sd. Warrant is as sig. over unto Peter Gaudy Junr. of the County afd.

These are humbly to Certify that J. James Rownd Dep. Surg. of Worcester County under the Hon. Col. Benj. Young have accordingly sur. and laid out for the afd. Peter Gaudy Junr. of the County afd. all that Tract or parcel of Land called Woolf Ridge situate lying and being in the County afd. back in Neicomis Honorist bounded as follows Beginning at a marked White Oak standing on a flat called Woolf pits Ridge on the North side of a Savannah and on the South west side of a Tract of Land sur. for Samuel Hall thence running North thirty five deg. East one Hundred and sixty poles thence South fifty five deg. East fifty poles thence South thirty five deg. West one Hundred and sixty poles thence with a right line to the first Bounder containing and now laid out for fifty acres of Land more or less to be holden of the maner of Worcester
