Survey of 50 acres of land located in Worcester County Maryland and known as "Piney Ridge" on 12 February 1764 for Peter Gordy II. The land was acquired by warrant on 20 October 1763. 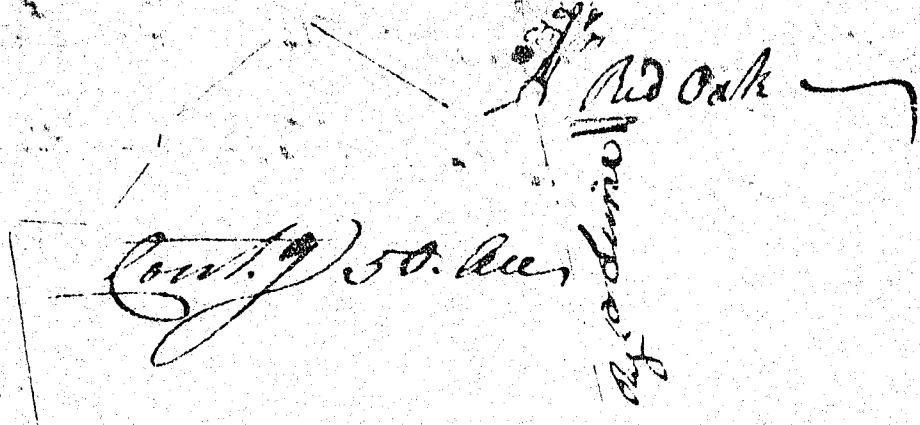

 the Hon. Benj. Young Esq. Mag. Gen. of the Customs Shore have Awarded
 say. of Land unto for the use of Peter Gaudy Just. of the County of Worcester all that Tract or
 parcel of Land called Piney Ridge situate lying & being in the
 County of Worcester bounded as follows To wit: at a marked Red Oak standing
 on the North side of a small run that runs into the little branch on the
 Edge of a running ground on the W. side of Pocumoke River there being
 N. 49. W. 42 yds. thence N. 30. E. 40 yds. thence S. 75. E. 16 yds. thence N. 49. E. 20 yds.
 thence S. 55. E. 30 yds. thence S. 6. E. 20 yds. thence S. 8. W. 30 yds. thence
 S. 56. W. 15 yds. thence S. 10. E. 100 yds. thence S. 80. W. 100 yds. thence with a
 right line to the first accidental corner of new laid out for 50. acs.
 of Land more or less to be holden of the Manor of Worcester
